FUEL

Fuel Available from BP Ferry Street, Independent Fuel Supplies Gympie Road, Matilda Fuel Supplies Cnr Walker & Ferry Street, Mobil Service Station 15 Saltwater Creek Road.

The above fuel suppliers will be used to provide a known fuel sample that the Machine Examiners will use for all fuel testing for this event.

This is information only. It is not mandatory to use these fuel suppliers. Any irregularities found with the fuel, further testing will occur using the SSA Inc. fuel testing Provider.

INSURANCE:

Competitor Personal Accident Insurance is compulsory.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Open to ASCF/SSA/NASR Licensed Drivers and SSA Inc Registered Modified Production sedans.
2. Drivers ASCF/NASR Licence Number, SSA Inc. Infringement Card Number and Registered vehicle's SSA Inc. Log Book Number must be included on the form, or this form will not be accepted.
3. All vehicle engines must be sealed
4. All nominations received after Friday 22nd February 2008, will be classed as late nominations and will be required to pay a late nomination fee of \$500.00 (inclusive of GST).
5. Late nominations will not be received after the closure of scrutineering.
6. Nominations fees, once received, will not be refunded.
7. All tow money, bonus money, prize money and transponder refunds will be paid no sooner than 21 days after the event. NO money will be paid at the track.
8. All hired transponders *must* be returned at the end of the event.
9. The SSA Inc reserves the right to refuse any Nomination.
10. **Mandatory** use of Transponders & One Way communicators will be in force for this title. If you do not have your own transponder they will be supplied by the QSCA Inc on race day. All competitors **MUST** have their own radio receiver."One Way Communicators are compulsory.
