

Drivers Ready for New Season

With the start of the new season just two weeks away, it is time to take a look at the latest news and developments amongst some of the drivers taking part in the 2006/2007 A.S. Concrete Pumping Super Sedan Championship Series. The Super Sedan Association-sanctioned competition will be staged over 16 rounds, kicking off at Brisbane International Speedway on September 30.

Headlining the driver line-up is defending series champion Wayne Randall, who will have a brand new Rocket Pontiac Grand Prix at his disposal for the coming season. With continued sponsorship support from Crimsafe, AFCO Shock Doctor, Lumby Transport, Treads International and Performance wholesale, Randall will be confident of repeating his success from last season, which included victory in the inaugural National Super Sedan Series.

Other drivers with new mounts for this season include SSA President Paul Geary, Sunshine Coast-based Peter Warren and last year's rookie star in Steve Jordan, who will be piloting a new Sweet chassis constructed by Matt Pascoe. Des Korn is also expected to unveil a new car midway through the season.

In other news, Dale Christensen will switch from a Ford Falcon to a Holden Monaro, veteran John Leslight has secured some valuable sponsorship support from EasTrack Quarries and Jack Childs has procured a new transporter as part of his plans to contest more series rounds this season from his Rockhampton base.
