Discussion held – response to be written covering the following points: -

- Title information documents have not listed medallions for the last year.
- Other items were introduced i.e. drinks coolers and were well received. A different item for next season titles is being sourced.
- Suggestion to follow the SSA lead and get small (keyboard size) corflute signs for A Main qualifier (Read A Main qualifier- no position so they are all the same and easier to distribute)
- Previously titles had time dedicated to introduce the competitors, present medallions, with crew to assist
  driver into car and belt up –the pit crew left the track and took the medallion back to the pits.
   Unfortunately, if there are time factors this is the first thing to get cut from the race program.
- Medallions then just get put into log book packets numerous log books continue to be presented for the
  rest of the season with the title medallion still in the log book
- Some competitors take their medallion home and probably end up in a draw out of sight, give it to their kids/grandkids to play with. Speak to people about trophies and where do they end up? In boxes, in storage, given away etc.
